Environmental policy

Purpose

To encourage a commitment to protecting the environment, we are continually looking for new ways to reduce the environmental impact of our activities.

Aim

We aim to:

- use local people and materials where possible to reduce our carbon footprint and to support our community
- obtain recycled and recyclable paper and environmentally-friendly cleaning products
- recycle waste for collection in accordance with local regulations
- rectify water leakages and use economical flush systems
- install energy-efficient lighting
- optimise power usage and utilise renewable energy when cost-effective
- turn off when not in use and/or review timers for lighting, heating and cooling equipment, having regard to the operational and security requirements of essential production, network and transmission equipment
- reduce the need to travel by promoting the use of teleconferencing
- minimise paper usage by issuing and archiving documents in digital form
- develop automation options for internal and external communications
- involve staff, volunteers and suppliers in the implementation of this policy, for greater commitment and improved performance, and offer training where possible
